- Discuss topics that interest you – but please be reasonable.
- Share professional opportunities suitable for ISS graduates.
- Organize and promote formal and in-formal meetings, or other events relevant for RSM graduates.
- Post photos of meetups.
- Handle all the data/information shared here with care.

In this group, please refrain from:

- political advocacy
- commercial advertising (unless there is a prior agreement with the ISS Alumni team allowing it)
- spamming or repetitive posts
- **ANY discrimination, harassment or bullying**
