

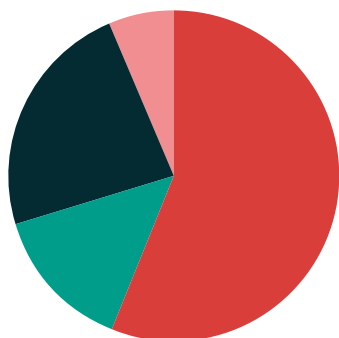


Facts and figures 2017/2018

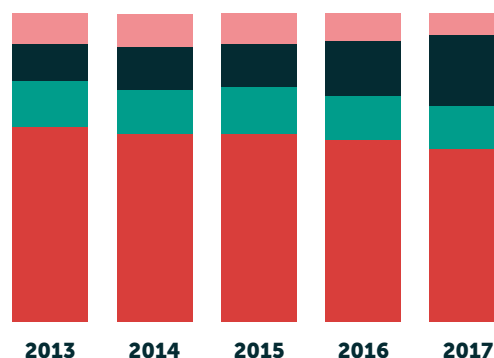

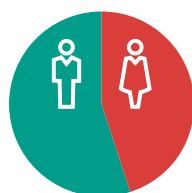

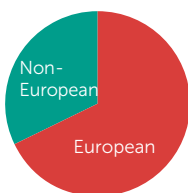

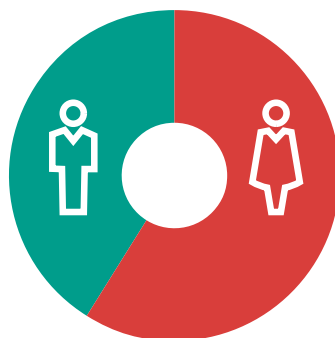

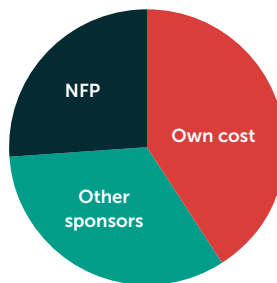

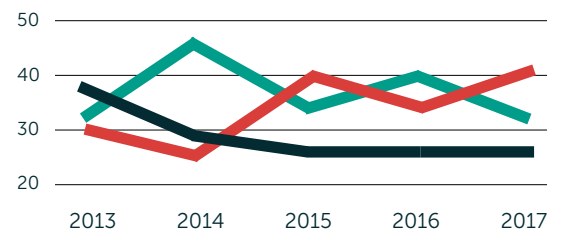

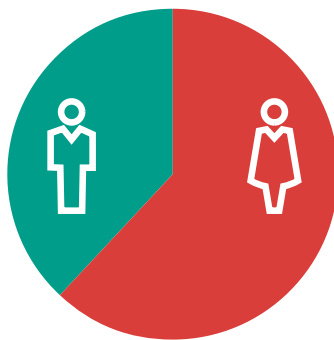
Source of funding



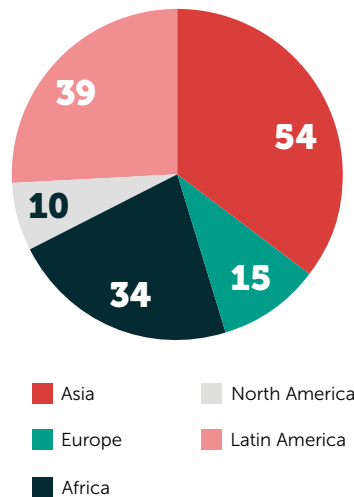
Trends in sources of funding MA students (%)

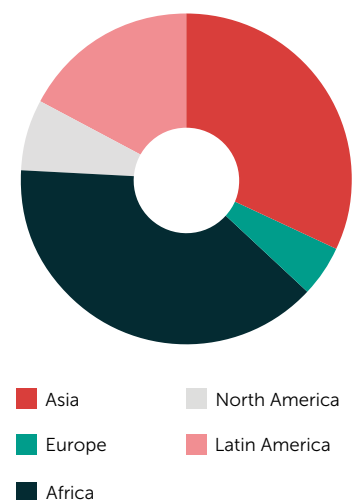
